

THE VILLAGE IS PLEASED TO ANNOUNCE THE GLENDALE TREE CANOPY PROGRAM

- The program is designed to help restore the Village tree canopy that significantly contributes to making the village a great place to live.
- Unfortunately, the village tree canopy has been in decline over the past decade due to storms, drought, natural age of the trees, power line trimming, and infestations such as the Emerald Ash Borer and the Dutch Elm disease. We have lost approximately 1,000 trees mostly on public lands during the last decade! This does not include trees removed on private property such as yours.
- The Glendale Park Board has been planting 50-70 trees every year on public property. This is not enough trees to maintain let alone restore the Village tree canopy.
- As a result, all residents are challenged to plant one or more canopy type trees on their properties during the next 3 years to help restore the village tree canopy. There are just over 1,000 private properties in the Village which would go a long way towards restoring our tree canopy.
- The canopy type trees recommended by the Glendale Park Board are trees that will grow to be 50-60 feet at maturity, provide a higher degree of resistance to diseases, are native or grow well in SW Ohio. , and provide a beautiful tree canopy for the properties

The recommended canopy type trees include the following:

- Sugar Maple
- Shingle Oak
- White Oak
- Chinquapin Oak
- Bald Cypress
- Tulip Tree
- River Birch
- London Plane
- Dawn Redwood
- American Beech
- Thornless Honey Locust
- Celebration Maple

ORDERING/PRICING

- Cassinelli's Glendale Nursery has again offered discounted package prices for the suggested trees that include consultation, site preparation, planting, mulching, and a water bag that is critical for new tree survivability in the critical first years, deer protection, and a 1-year warranty. A great deal for Glendale residents!
- If you currently work with a nursery, check with their personnel about trunk diameter, price, best location and planting procedure. Make sure a water bag is available and deer protection is provided.
- Fall and early winter are the best times of the year to plant these canopy trees because the environment is more ideal for younger trees to survive.
- **Any of the selected canopy type trees 1.5–2.0" diameter (8-10 feet tall when planted) - \$315.00**
- **Any of the selected canopy type trees 1.0-1.5" diameter (6-8 feet tall when planted) - \$255.00**
- Payment by cash or check directly to the Cassinelli's Glendale Nursery is due at time of planting.
- Other trees may be selected but will not receive the above package pricing with water bags and deer protection.
