

Village of Glendale Free Adopt-A- Tree Program



500 FREE seedlings will be available for Adoption Monday, March 9th in the lobby of the Village Office in celebration of Arbor Day 2020 and our Tree City USA status.

To celebrate Arbor Day (Friday, April 24th) and Glendale, Ohio being named a Tree City USA for the 24th consecutive year, the Village of Glendale Park Board has purchased 500 tree seedlings for adoption by Glendale residents. As a Tree City USA, Glendale relies on the work of many volunteers and funds received from supportive residents. As a Park Board team, we have annually demonstrated a commitment to populate and reforest your famous Glendale tree canopy. Bald Cypress, River Birch, Black Gum, and Chestnut seedlings will be available beginning **Monday, March 9th** in the Village Office. Please stop by and pick out your tree seedling soon.

Your free tree seedling should be planted within 24 hours. For the first year, each seedling will need special care by watering and feeding them as needed so that their roots can become established. An Arbor Day proclamation commemorating this event will be presented for adoption during the April 1st, 2020 meeting of your Village of Glendale Council.

Please remember that Glendale residents can also commemorate new births with the planting of a street tree! The Glendale Park Board plants sturdy street trees in celebration of new Glendale births each year. Each tree is planted with a small plaque and the family receives a proclamation from the Mayor.
