WHEREAS, the Vikings had six undefeated regular season records, and

WHEREAS, Pat Mancuso has had a positive influence on the lives of many young individuals, helping them to obtain college scholarships and helping them again when they returned to live in our local communities, and

WHEREAS, Pat Mancuso has already been selected by his peers to be a member of the Ohio High School Football Coaches Hall of Fame, and

WHEREAS, Pat Mancuso has recently announced his plans to retire from coaching the Princeton Vikings.
